PRIVATE INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

I know and acknowledge that neither the Board of Education of Rochelle Township High School District 212, nor its members, employees, agents, and programs provides insurance for personal injury to any student participating in extracurricular athletic activities or other programs. I agree, acknowledge and accept that participation in extra-curricular athletic activities is an inherently risky endeavor. Accordingly, as a condition of participation in such extra-curricular athletic programs, I acknowledge that I will provide such insurance as the School and/or I may deem necessary to protect my child from all hazards of extra-curricular sports participation, including but not limited to sports related injuries and medical conditions.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, I waive, on behalf of myself, my spouse, and my child or children any claim against Rochelle Township High School District 212, its Board, Board members, employees and agents for medical or related costs associated with my child or children's participation in extra curricular activities.

Extra Curricular Participation Insurance Coverage

Rochelle Township High School District 212 maintains Student Accident Secondary Insurance for all students for injuries sustained while attending school or participating in school-sponsored activities. The District's insurance is a supplemental plan. It is secondary to the student's personal insurance, which is the primary coverage.

Any injury must be <u>immediately</u> reported to the school advisor or coach and nurse. To be eligible for coverage, the parent must promptly report the claim on written forms available in the nurse's office, provide proof the incident has been claimed under the student's primary insurance, and provide such other information as the school's carrier may require.
